Temporary Jail Visitation Policies

Effective Monday June 8, 2020 Until Revised by the Hardin County Sheriff

According to Hardin County Policy; All Persons Entering the Law Enforcement Center Must Have a Pre-Approved Appointment for COVID Tracking Purposes. *No Walk Ins will be Accepted.*

The Appointment Line is 641-939-8189 Monday – Friday from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM

Public Visitation

Female visitation is available Monday through Friday from 8:30 AM – 12 Noon.

Male visitation is available Monday through Friday from 12:30 PM – 4:00 PM.

- All visits last 20 minutes with no exceptions.
- You must make an appointment to visit a detainee. The number is 641-939-8189.
- The visitation office is open Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM.
- You must use your visit prior to calling and scheduling another.
- Visits will be scheduled on the half hour.
- 1 adult and 1 child can visit at a time. Only 2 visitation booths are available.
- Each detainee is allowed two (2) visits per week.
- No one is allowed in the lobby except the actual approved visitors.
- Masks are available and highly recommended for visitors.
- Masks are required at all times for detainees.
- Sanitizer wipes are available and you are required to clean the area prior to and after each visit. Failure to do so will result in future visitation requests being rejected.
- All other provisions of existing policies regarding public visitation remain in effect.

Attorney Visitation

Attorney visitation is available Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM.

- Attorneys are required to wear a mask prior to entry into the administration area.
- Attorneys must make an appointment prior to the visit by calling 641-939-8189.
- Hand and sanitizer wipes are available for use and are encouraged to be used.
- All other provisions of existing policies regarding attorney visitation remain in effect.

Public Fingerprinting

Fingerprinting is reinstated Monday through Friday by appointment by calling 641-939-8189.
