- 7. Public Health Discussion: Water Fluoridation and COVID-19
- a. Discussion on benefits of fluoride in water and current status of Hardin County community's fluoride levels of 35 milligrams per liter. Eldora and Iowa Falls have natural levels half of what is recommended. As of January 12, 2021, Eldora decided to discontinue the water fluoridation process. Delta Dental foundation has grants available up to \$25,000 to upgrade systems. Discussion about a position statement from the Board of Health to participate in the fluoridation of the water.
- b. Discussion on whether or not the Hardin County Board of Health can change quarantine guidelines for Hardin County. The Board of Health goes by the guidance of the Iowa Department Public Health and doesn't feel they can change the guidelines at this time.
