HARDIN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MINUTES – JULY 24, 2019 WEDNESDAY - 10:00 A.M. COURTHOUSE LARGE CONFERENCE ROOM

Chair Reneé McClellan called the meeting to order. Also present were Supervisors Lance Granzow and BJ Hoffman; and Justin Ites, Taylor Roll, Megan Mollenbeck, Lydia Reichenbacher, Dave Dunn, Curt Groen, Dave McDaniel, Jessie Harken, Angela Raymond, Jessica Lara, Mark Buschkamp, Don Knoell, Donna Juber, Micah Cutler, Rick Gustin, and Nancy Lauver.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Hoffman moved, Granzow seconded to approve the agenda as posted. Motion carried.

Utility Permits: None.

Secondary Roads Department:

A departmental update was provided by County Engineer Taylor Roll. No action was necessary; informational only.

Hoffman moved, Granzow seconded that the following Resolution No. 2019-28, Resolution for Road Reclassification Public Hearing, be adopted. Roll call vote: "Ayes" Hoffman, Granzow, and McClellan. "Nays" None. Resolution No. 2019-28 is hereby adopted as follows:

RESOLUTION FOR ROAD RECLASSIFICATION PUBLIC HEARING Hardin County Resolution No. 2019-28

<u>WHEREAS</u>, A petition has been filed with the Hardin County Engineer asking that action be taken to reclassify a section of Hardin County Secondary Road to Class C, described as follows:

A portion of G Avenue, originally established on the 2nd of July, 1906 (Road Record Book 3, Page 269) as Gilbert Consent Highway, lying in Section 12, T-886N, R22W, Buckeye Township of Hardin County, Iowa. The extent of this road reclassification is the portion of the roadway commencing at the North Right-of-Way line of 180th Street, thence running in a Northerly direction approximately one-half mile to the terminus.

<u>NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED</u> that a hearing on the proposed reclassification will be held in the Conference Room, Hardin County Courthouse, Eldora, Iowa 50627 at 10:05 A.M. on the 7th Day of August, 2019 in accordance with Iowa Code Chapter 306.

Granzow moved, Hoffman seconded to approve the change of status for Angela Silvey, Elections Deputy, Auditor's Office, effective 7/29/2019 at \$41,048. Motion carried.

Hoffman moved, Granzow seconded that the following Resolution No. 2019-29, Resolution Authorizing the Chair to Sign the 28E Agreement for Iowa Precinct Atlas Consortium, be adopted. Roll call vote: "Ayes" Hoffman, Granzow, and McClellan. "Nays" None. Resolution No. 2019-29 is hereby adopted as follows:

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-29 RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR TO SIGN THE 28E AGREEMENT FOR IOWA PRECINCT ATLAS CONSORTIUM

WHEREAS, the purpose of the agreement is to provide an organizational structure to purchase a copyright license for distribution and use of Precinct Atlas within the State of Iowa; and,

WHEREAS, authority for this agreement is contained in Chapter 28E of the Code of Iowa.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Hardin County Board of Supervisors to authorize the Chair to sign the 28E Agreement for Iowa Precinct Atlas Consortium.

Chair Reneé McClellan called the meeting to order. Also present were Supervisors Lance Granzow and BJ Hoffman; and Megan DiCesare, Darrell Meyer, Mike Galloway, Taylor Roll, Julie Duhn, and Nancy Lauver.

The special meeting was held with Megan DiCesare, IRVM Department, for a departmental planning session and employment job review.

The job review materials haven't been compiled, so that item will be placed on a future agenda.

Items discussed and consensus reached:

- 1. Spraying priority was met.
- 2. Other priorities remain, but can now include hydro-seeding as well.
- 3. IRVM and Engineer will continue to communicate to meet priorities.
- 4. As a department head and manager of employees, Megan has "exempt" status.
- 5. Megan will avoid employee hours exceeding 30 hrs/wk on annual average.
- 6. Brush spraying will be walked, unless OSHA/DOT/DOL can be satisfied.
- 7. IRVM will hire PT seasonal to fill the vacancy occurring on or about 8/10.
- 8. Winter personnel will include Megan and one other person.
- 9. IRVM budget management will benefit from good communication with BOS.
- 10. Megan can comp IRVM fulltime person, but avoid being short-handed for weed spraying season.

No action was taken; planning and discussion only.
