MINUTES – APRIL 14, 2021
WEDNESDAY - 9:00 A.M.
COURTHOUSE LARGE CONFERENCE ROOM

Chair BJ Hoffman called the meeting to order. The meeting was held electronically due to COVID-19 public health risks. Also present were Supervisors René McClellan and Lance Granzow; and Jolene Pieters, Machel Eichmeier, Michael Pearce, Darrell Meyer, and Angela Silvey. Attending via Zoom: Carrie Kube, Justin Ites, Laura Cunningham, Matt Jones, Pauline Lloyd, Julie Duhn, John Zimmerman, Rocky Reents, Felicia Ledbetter, Shane Glinski, Elaine Loring, Linn Adams, Donna Juber, and Kala Eller.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Granzow moved, McClellan seconded to approve the agenda as posted. Motion carried.

McClellan moved, Granzow seconded to approve the minutes of April 7, 2021. Motion carried.

McClellan moved, Granzow seconded to approve the April 14, 2021 claims for payment. Motion carried.

Emergency Management Update: No report.

Public Health Update:

Rocky Reents, Public Health Coordinator, reported on COVID-19 case data and vaccine administration.

Utility Permits:

McClellan moved, Granzow seconded to approve Utility Permit No. UT-005, submitted by Heart of Iowa Communications Cooperative. Motion carried.

McClellan moved, Granzow seconded to approve Utility Permit No. UT-21-006, submitted by Heart of Iowa Communications Cooperative. Motion carried.

Secondary Roads: No report.

Public Comments:

Questions and comments were received from Pauline Lloyd, Julie Duhn, and Donna Juber about their tax assessments. Juber also asked when the budget hearing video recording would be posted.

McClellan moved, Granzow seconded to approve the 2021 Child Abuse Prevention Month Proclamation. Motion carried.

Other Business:

Granzow advised that April was Parkinson's Awareness Month, and Hardin County has a Parkinson's support group which meets the second Wednesday of the month, April through October, at 2 p.m., at the Ackley Civic Center.

Hoffman stated he was part of the welcome home ceremony for the Iowa National Guard 1-133 Infantry "Ironman" Battalion in Waterloo and was excited to have its members back in our communities.

Granzow moved, McClellan seconded to adjourn. Motion carried.

At 2:00 p.m. the Board met for an ATV/UTV ordinance work session. The meeting was held electronically due to COVID-19 public health risks. Present: Supervisors Hoffman and Granzow; and Robert Harms, Lori Kadner, Michael Pearce, Jarret Wininger, Heidi Young, Cheryl Lawrence, Taylor Roll, Angela De La Riva, Jolene Heikens, Bryan Meints, Darrell Meyer, and Angela Silvey. Attending via Zoom: April Neubauer, Matt Jones, Matthew Rezab, Kimberly Fistler Scallon, Erik Graham, Mike Fistler, Mandy Meyer, and Kim Wininger. Supervisor McClellan was absent.

Hoffman acknowledged a bill regarding ATVs and UTVs on county highways had circulated at the Statehouse, but that bill may not contain enough regulations or consider what works best for Hardin County.

Recorder Lori Kadner raised questions she had about a proposed County ordinance, and discussion ensued on permit administration, decals, fees, routes, County and individual liability, and safety.

Hoffman and Granzow expressed concerns about including ATVs in the ordinance. Hoffman noted most UTV side-by-sides have rollover protection and seatbelts, whereas ATVs do not. Granzow added that ATVs could tear up roadway due to riders playing on the road.

At the direction of the County's insurance company, County Engineer Taylor Roll mapped out routes safe for ATV/UTV use. Roll urged the County communicate with each city to see which are on board with an ordinance, as Roll would like his routes to connect to cities where allowed.

County Attorney Darrell Meyer suggested making the ordinance similar to surrounding counties' so riders are in compliance when they cross county lines.

Hoffman asked that the proposed ordinance be sent back to the County Economic Development Advisory Council and anyone wanting changes should contact Angela De La Riva.

It was decided that as long as an ATV/UTV is registered, no fee, permit, or decal will be required to travel county roads.

It was also agreed that Kadner should contact State Sen. Annette Sweeney and persuade her to reintroduce the ATV/UTV legislation at the Statehouse.

At 3:01 p.m. Granzow moved, Hoffman seconded to adjourn. Motion carried.

Secondary Roads:

County Engineer Taylor Roll reported on bridge construction progress and that he has been attending the National Association of County Engineers conference virtually.

IFADC Update:

Mark Buschkamp, Executive Director, briefed the Board on IFADC projects, leads, and activities.

Public Comments:

Donna Juber clarified comments she made the prior week pertaining to the Assessor's Office.

Pauline Lloyd wondered what could be done to increase Hardin County's vaccinated population. Craighton responded that 11,000 vaccinations had been given in the county, an excellent rate.

Granzow moved, Hoffman seconded that the following Resolution No. 2021-18, Resolution Approving Loan Agreement and Amended and Restated Indenture of Trust, be adopted. Roll Call Vote: "Ayes" Granzow and Hoffman. "Nays" None. Resolution No. 2021-18 is hereby adopted as follows:

Resolution No. 2021-18

RESOLUTION APPROVING LOAN AGREEMENT AND
AMENDED AND RESTATED INDENTURE OF TRUST

WHEREAS, Hardin County, State of Iowa (the "County") previously issued its General Obligation Urban Renewal Bonds, Series 2012 and loaned the proceeds to the Ellsworth Municipal Hospital d/b/a Hansen Family Hospital (the "Hospital") to provide additional financing for the construction of an approximately \$30 million hospital building improvement project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the City of Iowa Falls, Iowa (the "City") provided for repayment of the loan from the County to the Hospital for the Project with a pledge of Net Revenues of the Hospital, said Net Revenues being used to abate debt service on the 2012 General Obligation Urban Renewal Bonds; and

WHEREAS, the County has accepted a proposal from UMB Bank, n.a. to refund the 2012 General Obligation Urban Renewal Bonds; and

WHEREAS, to accomplish the refunding it is necessary to enter into a new loan agreement with the City acting for the Hospital and to amend restate the Indenture of Trust providing for the terms and conditions for repayment of the loan from the Net Revenues of the Hospital.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE Board of Supervisors OF Hardin County, STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Approval of Indenture. The Amended and Restated Indenture, in substantially the form and content now before this meeting, is hereby approved, authorized, and confirmed, and the Board Chairperson and the Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the Amended & Restated Indenture of Trust with such changes, modifications, additions or deletions approved by the County Auditor and County Treasurer, upon the advice of bond counsel.

Section 2. Approval of Loan Agreement. The Loan Agreement, in substantially the form and content now before this meeting, is hereby approved, authorized, and confirmed, and the Board Chairperson and the Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the Loan Agreement with such changes, modifications, additions or deletions approved by the County Auditor and County Treasurer, upon the advice of bond counsel.

Section 3. Further Actions. The Board hereby authorizes and directs the Auditor, Treasurer and Chairperson of the Board of Supervisors to carry out or cause to be carried out, and to perform, such obligations of the County and such other actions, including the execution of ancillary documents, they shall consider necessary to carry out the intents and purposes of this Resolution, the Amended and Restated Indenture of Trust and the Loan Agreement.

Resolution 2021 - _____ Bridge Weight Limit Postings

WHEREAS, in accordance with the requirement of the Federal Government, certain bridges located on the Secondary Road System must be posted with load limit signs; and

WHEREAS, a bridge inspection program covering all Secondary Highway bridges in Hardin County, is being completed biennially; and

WHEREAS, a number of such bridges have been found to require load limit posting as determined by criteria established by the Federal Government.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Hardin County Board of Supervisors on this 28th day of April, 2021 as provided in Sections 321.471, 321.472, and 321.473, Code of Iowa, to erect and/or maintain weight limit signs in advance of the following bridges located on the Federal Aid, Farm to Market, and Local Secondary Road System. The County Engineer is instructed to place or cause to be placed, all necessary signs to comply with this resolution. Only those bridges determined to have a weight restriction below LEGAL, in the listing included herein, will be required to have signs erected.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: Due to changes in the status of the bridges on the Secondary Roads in Hardin County brought about by repair, replacement, or re-inspection, all previous resolutions regarding the posting of these bridges in Hardin County is hereby superseded.

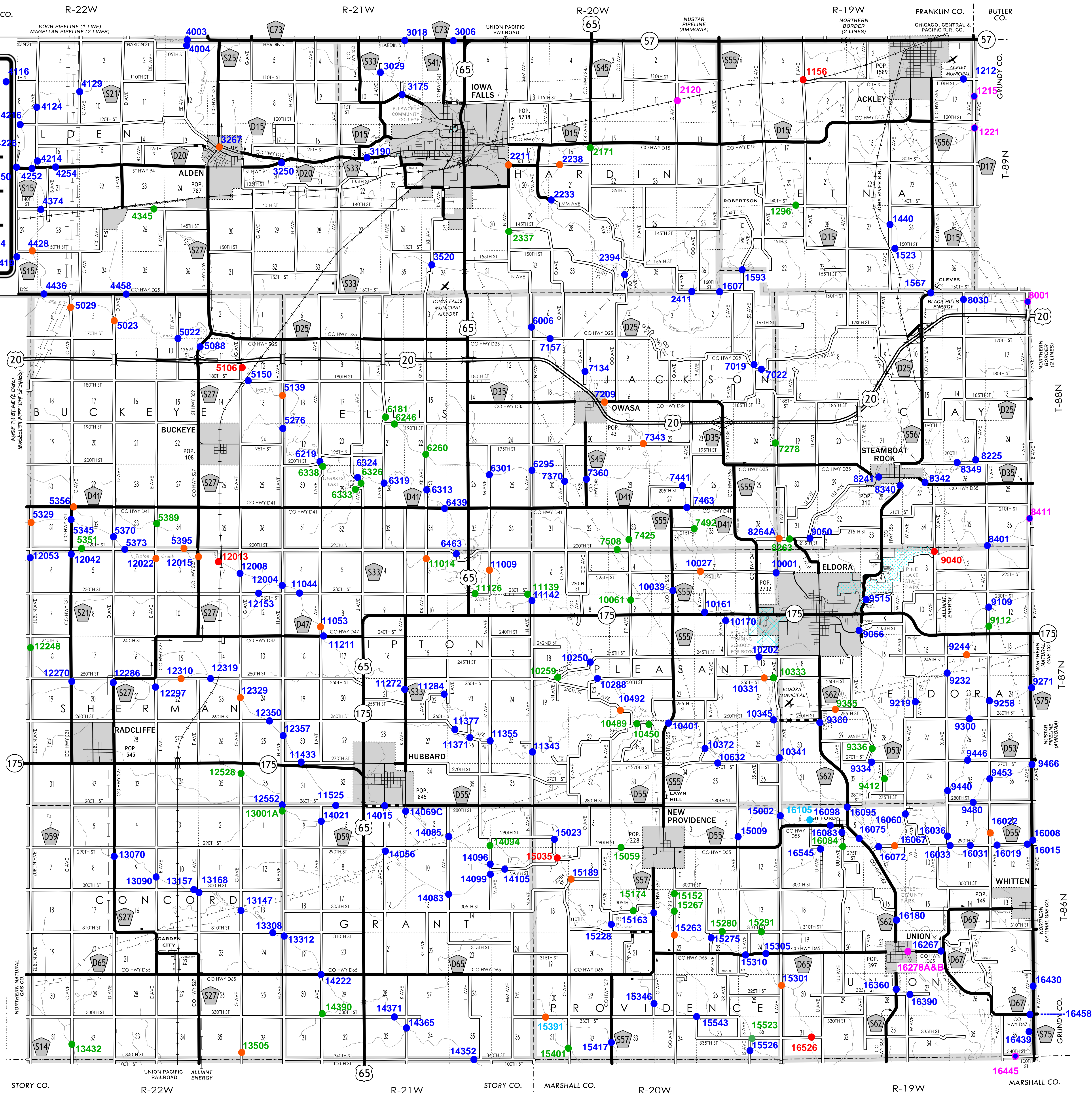
