### HARDIN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MINUTES – APRIL 11, 2022 MONDAY – 3:00 P.M. COURTHOUSE LARGE CONFERENCE ROOM

Board Chair BJ Hoffman called the meeting to order. Supervisor Renee McClellan was in attendance and Supervisor Lance Granzow joined via phone. Also attending were Taylor Roll, Machel Eichmeier, Michael Pearce, and Jolene Pieters. Attending via Zoom: Elaine Loring and Donna Juber.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

McClellan moved, Granzow seconded to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Granzow moved, McClellan seconded to approve the minutes from 04/06/22. Motion carried.

McClellan moved, Granzow seconded to approve the claims for payment for 04/13/22. McClellan discussed the amount of \$600.00 paid to Solid Waste and Recycling for disposal of tires and appliances. Taylor Roll confirmed that they are cleaning ditches and do this multiple times each year. McClellan requested that if anyone sees someone dumping things in the ditches that they turn them in due to costing the taxpayers money not only for the disposal, but the labor involved. Motion carried.

Granzow moved, McClellan seconded to approve the Heart of Iowa Communication Coop Utility Permit UF22-005. Motion carried.

Attorney Darrell Meyer was unable to attend this meeting. Hoffman stated that Attorney Meyer recommended to approve the Livestock at Large Ordinance, waive the second reading and consider the final reading on April 20, 2022.

McClellan moved, Granzow seconded to approve the first reading of the Livestock at Large Ordinance. McClellan stated that we had acted upon this ordinance previously, but with Ordinance No. 1, which has been repealed, the County is now in line with the State of Iowa Code and are acting upon this Ordinance again. Motion carried.

McClellan moved, Granzow seconded to set the final reading of the Livestock at Large Ordinance for April 20, 2022 at the regular Board of Supervisors meeting. Motion carried.

Granzow moved, McClellan seconded to approve the Sheriff Department's monthly report for March. Motion carried.

McClellan moved, Granzow seconded to approve the change of status, increase of salary, for Michelle Kuechenberg due to her completing her first 6 months of employment in the Auditor's office. Effective April 11, 2022. Motion carried.

McClellan moved, Granzow seconded to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried.

<ol> <li>WRITTEN NOTICE</li> <li>At least five (5) working days prior to the proposed installation, an applicant shall file with the County Engineer a written notice stating the time, date, location, and nature of the proposed installation.</li> </ol>
3. INSPECTION  The County Engineer may provide a full-time inspector during the installation of all lines to ensure compliance with this Utility Permit. The inspector shall have the right, during reasonable hours and after showing proper identification, to enter any installation site in the discharge of the inspector's official duties, and to make any inspection or test that is reasonably necessary to protect the public health, safety, and welfare.
4. INSPECTION FEES The applicant shall pay actual costs directly attributable to the installation inspection conducted by the County Engineer. Within thirty (30) days after completion of the installation, the County Engineer shall submit a statement for inspection services rendered. The applicant agrees to reimburse the county within thirty (30) days of billing.
5. REQUIREMENTS The installation inspector shall assure that the following requirements have been met:
<ul> <li>A. Construction signing shall comply with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices</li> <li>B. Depth – (Add additional depth if ditch has silted to the thickness of the deposited silt.) The minimum depth of cover shall be as follows:</li> </ul>

D. The applicant shall use reference markers in the right-of-way (ROW) boundary to locate line and changes in alignment as required by the County Engineer. A permanent warning tape shall be placed one (1) foot

above all underground utility lines.

E. All tile line locations shall be marked with references located in the ROW line.F. No underground utility lines shall cross over a crossroad drainage structure without approval from the County Engineer.

G. Residents along the utility route shall have uninterrupted access to the public roads. An all weather access shall be maintained for residents adjacent to the project.

H. After construction, granular surfacing shall be added to the road by the applicant to restore the road to its original condition. After surfacing has been applied, the road surface shall be reviewed by the County

#### 6. NON-CONFORMING WORK

The County Engineer may halt the installation at any time if the applicant's work does not meet the requirements set forth in this Utility Permit Application.

#### 7. COUNTY INFRACTION

Violation of this permit is a county infraction under lowa Code Section 331.307, punishable by a civil penalty of \$100 for each violation. Each day that a violation occurs or is permitted to exist by the applicant constitutes a separate offense.

#### 8. HOLD HARMLESS

The utility company shall save this county harmless of any damages resulting from the applicant's operations. A copy of a certificate of insurance naming this county as an additional insured for the permit work shall be filed in the County Engineer's Office prior to installation. The minimum limits of liability under the insurance policy shall be \$1,000,000.

#### 9. PERMIT REQUIRED


No applicant shall install any lines unless such applicant has obtained a Utility Permit from the County Engineer and has agreed in writing that said installation will comply with all ordinances and requirements of the county for such work. Applicants agree to hold the county free from liability for all damage to applicant's property which occurs proximately as a result of the applicant's failure to comply with said ordinances or requirements.

#### 10. RELOCATION

The applicant shall, at any time subsequent to installation of utility lines, at the applicant's own expense, relocate or remove such lines as may become necessary to conform to new grades, alignment or widening of ROW resulting from maintenance or construction operations for highway improvements.

#### **ORDINANCE 2022-**

#### AN ORDINANCE REGULATING LIVESTOCK AT LARGE

**Purpose** A regulation relating to livestock running at large, establishing consequences for livestock and owner, and providing reasonable rights of notice and hearing before the imposition of penalties.

The Hardin County Board of Supervisors hereby adopts the following ordinance to wit:

#### 1.1 **Definitions**

- 1.1 (01) "Livestock" means an animal belonging to the bovine, caprine, equine, ovine, or porcine species; ostriches, rheas, or emus; farm deer or poultry.
- 1.1 (02) "At Large" means off the premises of the owner and not under the control of a competent person, restrained within a trailer, or housed in a veterinary hospital or kennel.
- 1.1 (03) "Owner" means the person who holds title to livestock or who is primarily responsible for the care and feeding of the livestock as provided by the titleholder.

#### 2.1 Violations

- 2.1 (01) At Large Prohibited. It is unlawful for any owner to allow livestock to run at large within Hardin County.
- 2.1 (02) Damage or Interference. It is unlawful for the owner of livestock to allow or permit such livestock to pass upon the premises of another thereby causing damage to, or interference with the premises, property or livestock of another.

#### 3.1 Penalties

- 3.1 (01) After receiving two prior warnings of violations of this Ordinance from any law enforcement official, any owner violating this Ordinance or any amendment or supplement thereto, may be found guilty of a simple misdemeanor which is punishable by a fine of not more than six hundred twenty-five dollars (\$625) or by imprisonment of not more than thirty (30) days.
- 3.1 (02) After receiving two prior warnings of violations of this Ordinance from any law enforcement official, the owner may, in the alternative, be found guilty of a county infraction punishable by a civil penalty of not more than seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$750), of if there has been a prior conviction for a violation of this Ordinance, then by a civil penalty not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000).
- 3.1 (03) Nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to prevent a landowner or local authority from taking custody of livestock as provided by Chapter 169C of the Iowa Code.

#### 4.1 Applicability

4.1 (01) Provisions contained herein are applicable to all unincorporated areas of Hardin County. 5.1 **Severability of Provisions** 5.1 (01) If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance. 6.1 **Regulation Effective Upon Publication** This ordinance being deemed essential and imperative for the preservation of the public health, shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law. 7.1 **Repeal of Previous Versions** 7.1 (01) This ordinance repeals and replaces any prior versions of this ordinance. 1<sup>st</sup> reading 2<sup>nd</sup> reading 3<sup>rd</sup> reading Passed and approved this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_\_, 2022. # MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE SANITARY LANDFILL LOCAL GOVERNMENT GUARANTEE

Guarantee made this 20<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2022 by Hardin County, Iowa, herein referred to as "Guarantor", which is a county organized under the laws of the State of Iowa. This guarantee is made by the Guarantor on behalf of the Rural Iowa Waste Management Association to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources, herein referred to as "IDNR", in an amount not to exceed five hundred thousand and no/100 dollars (\$500,000.00) lawful money of the United States.

**WHEREAS**, Section 455B.306 of the Code of Iowa requires financial assurance instruments for all sanitary disposal projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the Rural Iowa Waste Management Association has applied to the IDNR to operate a sanitary disposal project located within the State of Iowa, and is required pursuant to IAC 567 Chapter 113.14 to maintain financial assurance for closure and/or postclosure care in connection therewith; and

**WHEREAS**, IAC 567 Chapter 113.14(6)"h" provides for the "Local Government Guarantee" mechanism to be an acceptable financial assurance instrument, and Guarantor meets or exceeds the financial test criteria and agrees to comply with the requirements of said subrule; and

**WHEREAS**, the Rural Iowa Waste Management Association owns and/or operates the following municipal solid waste sanitary landfill facility covered by this Guarantee:

Rural Iowa Sanitary Landfill

Eldora, IA 50627
Closure Cost to be assured: \$\\_\$171,755.00
Postclosure Cost to be assured: \$\\_\$328,245.00

WHEREAS, the Guarantor guarantees to IDNR that in the event that the Rural Iowa Waste Management Association fails to perform closure and/or postclosure care of the above facility in accordance with the approved plan or other permit requirements, whenever required to do so, the Guarantor shall either perform closure and/or postclosure care, pay a third party to perform closure and/or postclosure care, establish a fully funded secured trust fund as specified in IAC 567 Chapter 113.14(6)"a", or establish an alternate financial assurance instrument in the name of the Rural Iowa Waste Management Agency in the amount of the current closure and/or postclosure cost estimate, as required by Chapter 113.14(6).

WHEREAS, the Guarantor agrees to remain bound under this Guarantee for as long as the Rural Iowa Waste Management Association must comply with the applicable financial assurance requirements of Chapter 113, except when the Guarantor provides written notice, by certified mail, of intent to terminate Guarantee, at least 120 days prior to the date said Guarantee is to be terminated. When such notice is provided, the Rural Iowa Waste Management Association shall, within 90 days, provide IDNR proof of alternate financial assurance or the IDNR shall call upon the Local Government Guarantee.

**WHEREAS**, the Guarantor expressly waives notice of acceptance of this Guarantee by the Rural Iowa Waste Management Agency or by IDNR. Guarantor also expressly waives notice of amendments or modifications of the site closure plan and of amendments or modifications of the facility permit(s).
