HARDIN COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 30 AMENDED REDISTRICTING AND REPRECINCTING ORDINANCE

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Hardin County, Iowa:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend Ordinance No. 30 establishing voting precincts as the result of the population changes reflected by the 2020 federal decennial census, in accordance with Iowa Code Sections 49.3, 49.4 and 49.7.

SECTION 2. Legal Description of Precincts:

lying east and north of the division line described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the centerline of Cadet Road and Taylor Avenue at the north corporation line, thence south along the centerline of Taylor Avenue to the intersection of said centerline with the centerline of Woodland Avenue, thence east along the centerline of Woodland Avenue to the intersection of said centerline with the centerline of River Street, thence south along the centerline of River Street to the intersection of said centerline with the centerline of the Iowa River, thence easterly and southerly along the centerline of the Iowa River to the eastern City limits.

Iowa Falls #2

Precinct number two shall comprise the area within the City limits lying west and south of the division line described above.

SECTION 3. Statement of population of each Precinct:

SECTION 4. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. Severability Clause. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective for all elections after January 15, 2022, final passage and publication as provided by law.
