

At the time set for public hearing the sealed bids will be opened and an auction will held for all qualified bidders, with the bidding to start at the highest qualifying sealed bid received. The Board of Supervisors propose to convey the above-described real properties by quit claim deed. The Round Barn property will be conveyed with the covenant that the property structure shall be maintained intact, with a reversion clause.

MEAL REIMBURSEMENT

WHEREAS, the Hardin County Board of Supervisors adopted on or about June 16, 2010 Resolution 2010-25 Meal Reimbursement.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Hardin County hereby amends Resolution No. 2010-25, to include the attached provisions:

MEAL REIMBURSEMENT

The county will reimburse employees for meals needed while attending an approved educational training session outside the County. Reimbursement will be made for actual meal expenditures excluding alcoholic beverages, subject to the following guidelines:

Daily Meal Reimbursement	\$50.00
Gratuity	Up to 20%

The above are guidelines, with the Daily Maximum meal reimbursement not to exceed \$50.00 and up to 20% gratuity. Receipts for all meals must be provided. Meals during the normal course of performing an employee’s job will not be reimbursed. Reimbursement for meals when the employee is NOT in overnight status will be reported as taxable income in the next pay period and is subject to federal and state income tax withholding and Social Security Tax payments. Persons filing for meals reported for taxable income may only include their own individual meals, not those of other people. All application Internal Revenue Service regulations regarding reports of reimbursed expenses will be followed by the Auditor’s office.
