McClellan moved, Granzow seconded to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

McClellan moved, Granzow seconded to approve Heart of Iowa Ventures LLC Utility Permit UT-22-002 to install permanent fiber optic cable and peds. Motion carried.

Engineer Taylor Roll discussed the Bridge Weight Limit Postings received from their inspectors and the changes they made. The Board asked that the public respect the bridge weight limits so the bridges may last longer. McClellan moved, Granzow seconded that Resolution No. 2022-12, Resolution Bridge Weight Limit Postings be adopted. Roll Call Vote: “Ayes” Granzow, McClellan. “Nays” None. Absent: Hoffman. Motion carried. Resolution No. 2022-12 is hereby adopted as follows:

Resolution 2022 - 12
Bridge Weight Limit Postings

WHEREAS, in accordance with the requirement of the Federal Government, certain bridges located on the Secondary Road System must be posted with load limit signs; and

WHEREAS, a bridge inspection program covering all Secondary Highway bridges in Hardin County, is being completed biennially; and

WHEREAS, a number of such bridges have been found to require load limit posting as determined by criteria established by the Federal Government.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Hardin County Board of Supervisors on this 23rd day of March, 2022 as provided in Sections 321.471, 321.472, and 321.473, Code of Iowa, to erect and/or maintain weight limit signs in advance of the following bridges located on the Federal Aid, Farm to Market, and Local Secondary Road System. The County Engineer is instructed to place or cause to be placed, all necessary signs to comply with this resolution. Only those bridges determined to have a weight restriction below LEGAL, in the listing included herein, will be required to have signs erected.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: Due to changes in the status of the bridges on the Secondary Roads in Hardin County brought about by repair, replacement, or re-inspection, all previous resolutions regarding the posting of these bridges in Hardin County is hereby superseded.

HARDIN-GRUNDY COUNTY VETERANS AFFAIRS ADMINISTRATOR AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, Iowa Code Chapter 28E authorizes governmental entities such as Hardin County and Grundy County to enter into agreements to provide public services; and

WHEREAS, Hardin County currently is in need of assistance in delivering Veterans Affairs services; and

WHEREAS, Hardin County has requested that Grundy County enter an agreement to utilize Grundy County’s administrator on a temporary basis; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that Grundy County will assist Hardin County under the circumstances and will be compensated by Hardin County;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Hardin County, Iowa, that Hardin County adopts the attached agreement, to be executed by at least a majority of the Hardin County Board of Supervisors and directs the Hardin County Auditor to also execute the agreement, and further directs the Hardin County Attorney to deliver to the Grundy County Attorney a copy of this resolution and the executed agreement.
