HARDIN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MINUTES – SEPTEMBER 14, 2022 WEDNESDAY – 9:00 A.M. EOC TRAINING ROOM

Board Chair BJ Hoffman called the meeting to order. Supervisor Lance Granzow was present. Supervisor Renee McClellan was absent. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Granzow moved to approve the agenda as presented. Hoffman discussed moving the approval of abatements from the Assessor's office and the correction of utility taxes to the next week's agenda to provide additional time and to move Darrell Meyer's promotion of Constitution Day to immediately follow the approval of today's agenda.

Granzow moved, Hoffman seconded to amend the motion to approve the agenda made by Granzow. Motion carried.

Granzow moved, Hoffman seconded to approve the agenda with changes. Motion carried.

Darrell Meyer presented information about the Constitution Day program to be held Saturday September 17th, 2022, 10:30 to noon, on the Hardin County Courthouse lawn. In case of rain, it will be held at the Grande Theater across the street.


