MINUTES – OCTOBER 16, 2024

The Hardin County Board of Supervisors held their regular meeting at 9:00 AM on October 16, 2024, at the Hardin County Courthouse large conference room in Eldora, Iowa.

Board members in attendance were Lance Granzow, BJ Hoffman, and Renee McClellan. Also attending: Ann Larson, Taylor Roll, Jolene Pieters, Lori Kadner, Darrell Meyer, Thomas Craighton, Bri Amling, Elaine Loring-Jass, Donna Juber, and Julie Duhn.

McClellan moved and Granzow seconded to approve the agenda. All Ayes. Motion carried.

Hoffman moved and McClellan seconded to approve the minutes of October 09, 2024. All Ayes. Motion carried.

McClellan moved and Hoffman seconded the motion to approve claims for payment for October 16, 2024. All Ayes. Motion carried.

Hoffman moved and McClellan seconded to approve WageWorks Health Equity Plan for Calendar Year 2025. All Ayes. Motion carried.

Hoffman moved and McClellan seconded to approve Actuarial Services Agreement with HUB International Great Plains. All Ayes. Motion carried.

At 9:02 a.m. the Road Vacation Public Hearing was opened. There were no public comments. McClellan moved and Hoffman seconded the motion to close the public hearing. Roll Call was taken. Roll Call Vote: “Ayes” Granzow, Hoffman, and McClellan. “Nays” None. Motion carried.

Hoffman moved and McClellan seconded the motion to approve Resolution 2024-36 Resolution to Vacate a County Road – 180th Street East of U.S. Highway 65. Located in Hardin, County, Iowa. Roll Call was taken. Roll Call Vote: “Ayes” Granzow, Hoffman, and McClellan. “Nays” None. Motion carried. Resolution No. 2024-36 is hereby adopted as follows:

RESOLUTION TO VACATE A COUNTY ROAD

Hardin County Resolution No. 2024-36

WHEREAS, A public hearing was conducted on October 16th, 2024, following a publication and service of notice as required by law on the proposed vacation and closure of a section of Hardin County Secondary Road, described as follows:

That portion of the “Berlin and Hamilton County Line Road” now known as 180th Street, originally established on July 6th, 1857. (See Road Record Book 1, page 37, 45) all lying in sections 11, 12, 13 and 14, T88N, R 21W of Hardin County, Iowa.

The intention of this road closure is to vacate the entire segment of public road right-of-way of 180th Street from the N ¼ of NW ¼ of section 13, T88N, R21W, west to the east right-of-way line of U.S. Highway 65. Easement access rights shall be granted to all existing utilities on said described road vacation to allow access to their current facilities, now and in the future, for maintenance, repair, patrol, operation, and reconstruction to said facilities.

WHEREAS, no objections have been received, either in writing or by persons present.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Hardin County Board of Supervisors that the subject section be ordered vacated and closed. Passed and adopted this 16th day of October 2024.

McClellan moved and Hoffman seconded the motion to approve both Quit Claim Deeds for 180th Street. All Ayes. Motion carried.

Hoffman moved and McClellan seconded the motion to approve the resignation of Caleb Knutson for the Hardin County Board of Adjustment. All Ayes. Motion carried.

McClellan moved and Hoffman seconded the motion to acknowledge the VA First Quarter Report for FY 24/25. All Ayes. Motion carried.

Hoffman moved and McClellan seconded the motion to approve the change of status in the Auditor’s Office for the hiring of Wayne Riskedahl as a part-time temporary Election Clerk, at an hourly rate of \$14.00, effective October 16, 2024. All Ayes. Motion carried.

Hoffman moved and McClellan seconded the motion to approve the change of status in the Auditor’s Office for the hiring of Trinity Berends as a part-time temporary Election Clerk, at an hourly rate of \$14.00, effective October 16, 2024. All Ayes. Motion carried.

Other Business:

Roll stated that the D41 bridge is open, they are still working on the D45 and D65 bridges. Craighton stated that the burn ban is still in place.
