Hardin County Supervisor Chairman, Lance Granzow, opened the meeting. Also present were Hardin County Supervisors, Renee McClellan and BJ Hoffman; Mike Arnorfer with ADS; Contractors, Brian Hill with Hall Trenching & Backhoe, Ashly Graff with Graff Excavating, Ray Furst with Holland Contracting, and Mike Byron with Leymaster Tile; Lee Gallentine and James Sweeney with Ryken Engineering; Drainage Clerk, Tina Schlemme.

Hoffman moved, McClellan seconded to approve the agenda as presented. All ayes. Motion carried.

Gallentine opened the bids, in addition to verifying that the bids and bid bonds were all in order.

The PP Alt Bid was for polypropylene tile but with municipality standards, which includes mandrel testing, televising inspection, trench compaction and access points installed for mandrel and televising. The RCP Alt Bid was for concrete pipe.

Hoffman moved, McClellan seconded for Ryken Engineering to verify math and the Trustees will take action at their next regular drainage meeting. All ayes. Motion carried.
