

Dear Hardin County Supervisors,

Enclosed is your county's dues statement for the 2018-2019 fiscal year. For those that have supported us in the past with your membership, we urge you do so again. For those that have chosen not to participate, we hope you will consider doing so this year.

Membership costs only two and ½ cents/acre of land drained. Membership in the mutual protection fund is assessed at one and ¼ cent per acre drained. \*

Fighting the numerous challenges that drainage rights face requires a strong association. IDDA's strength comes from members who are willing to commit the necessary funds on an annual basis to keep the association moving forward.

Also included on your invoice is the assessment for the Mutual Protection Fund. Although it is voluntary, I strongly urge your participation. It is the mutual protection fund that gives IDDA the resources to play a larger role in the judicial and legislative arena and also allows the association to retain part-time legal counsel as a further service to our membership.

IDDA is working on your behalf in the state and federal regulatory arena, the court system, the state legislature and Congress. Thank you for your continued support of IDDA.


