To all lienholders or encumbrancers and actual occupants of any land within the district which includes all or parts of Sections 1 and 12 of Township 88 North, Range 22 West; all or parts of Sections 6 Township 88 North, Range 21 West; and Section 33 of Township 89 North, Range 21 West, and to all other person to whom it may concern:

YOU AND EACH OF YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that a public hearing on the Reclassification Report for Drainage District 9 shall be held on Wednesday, March 26, 2025, at 9:30 A.M in the lower-level conference room of the Hardin County Courthouse, 1215 Edgington Avenue, Eldora, Iowa.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that the Trustees of said drainage district acknowledged receipt of the Reclassification Commission Report for Drainage District 9 from Clapsaddle-Garber Associates

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that the Trustees for said drainage district shall at the public hearing set for Wednesday, March 26, 2025, hear comments and objections to the Reclassification Commission Report for Drainage District 9, as may be presented by or for any landowner in the district.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that a copy of the Reclassification Commission Report for Drainage District 9 is available in the Hardin County Drainage Clerk's Office and all objections hereto must be filed in writing with the Drainage Clerk at or before the time set for said hearing. Failure to file written objections will result in a waiver of any objections you may have.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that at the time for hearing, the Trustees of said drainage district, shall determine all objections filed to said report, shall fully consider report, and may affirm, increase or diminish the percentage of benefits or the apportionment of costs and expenses made in said report against anybody or tract of land in said district as may appear to the Trustees to be just and equitable.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that the reclassification sets out an assessment schedule which shall be the basis for all future assessments for current and future repairs and improvements.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that at the time of hearing, the Trustees of said drainage district shall determine all objections filed to said petitions, shall fully consider petitions, and may affirm or deny the requests for abandonment of individual laterals. Any petitions that are affirmed will be only after the Trustees have determined that the laterals that are the subject of the petitions are free from indebtedness and that the necessity for the continued maintenance thereof no longer exists or that the expense of the continued maintenance is not commensurate with the benefits derived therefrom.
