Notice is hereby given to the qualified voters of Hardin County, Iowa, that the 2024 Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, June 4, 2024. The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Voters are hereby notified that all 8 precincts will be open for this election. The polling places are as follows:

A public test of the vote tabulating equipment will be conducted in the Large Conference Room at the Hardin County Courthouse beginning on May 30, 2024 at 9:00 a.m. and continuing until completion of the required test.

Hardin County residents who are not registered to vote are encouraged to do so. Residents may register in the office of the County Auditor in person, may obtain a registration form online at [www.hardincountyiowa.gov](http://www.hardincountyiowa.gov), may request that a registration form be mailed to them, or may register online at [www.sos.ia.gov](http://www.sos.ia.gov). The deadline to pre-register to vote for this election is May 20, 2024. With appropriate identification, an eligible elector may also register to vote on Election Day in the precinct where the person lives.

Voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered or who have changed precincts are also required to provide proof of residence.

Any voter who cannot show ID may: 1) have voter’s identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct; 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents; or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the County Auditor’s office by noon on June 10, 2024. Voter Accessibility: All voting sites are fully accessible to persons with physical disabilities. Voters may choose another person to assist them to vote, except their employer, employer's agent, or an officer or agent of the voter's union.

Any voter who is physically unable to enter a polling place has the right to vote in the voter's vehicle.
