## Hardin County Conservation Rental Agreement For Truax "No Till" Drill

The use of this drill is a privilege and is intended to promote the restoration of native prairie wildlife habitat. Please treat it with care so that others can continue to use it and we can still afford to offer it for public use.

- Hardin County residents can rent the drill for \$30.00-per-acre (\$100.00 minimum). For use out of Hardin County, the cost is \$100.00 (out of county fee) along with the \$30.00-per-acre (\$100.00 minimum) cost. No contractor use is permitted.
- A <u>\$200.00</u> deposit will be required at the time of pick up. We ask that you make this deposit in the form of a check made payable to Hardin County Conservation. An inspection of the drill will be made at the time of pick up and again when it is returned. After an inspection, your check will be returned unless damage to the equipment is deemed negligent fault of the renter.
- There will be a horsepower restriction of 90-HP on the tractor used. This is due to people using too large of tractor and pulling the drill through stumps, rocks, etc., that they would normally avoid. Remember, the purpose of the drill is for seeding of Conservation Reserve Program (CRP) land, waterways and wildlife habitat. Please avoid its use in pasture and wooded areas.
- Due to the high demand of this piece of machinery, we ask that you pickup the drill no sooner than one-day before you plan to use it and keep it no more than three-days. This is negotiable if one is doing a larger tract of land (Ex. 40-acres). Please inform us of your planned usage at time of pick-up.
