

**HARDIN COUNTY CONSERVATION BOARD
PARK
FIREWOOD CUTTING & REMOVAL PERMIT**

A fee of \$100.00 is required for each saw cutter to cut wood from designated site

- Only persons assisting in cutting and/or hauling firewood are allowed in designated area.
- Access to the site will not be permitted when access road is snowed in or when muddy conditions exist. No Vehicles are allowed off maintained roads or trails unless ground is firm or frozen.
- Travel with vehicle will be allowed only on the designated site and access road to the area.
- Vehicles are not allowed to be left at the designated site between the hours of dark and daylight.
- Standing trees are not to be cut.
- Firewood cutting and removal will only be permitted at designated site specified in this permit.
- Cutting and removal will be allowed during the period of daylight to dark seven days a week.
- Chain saws, wood splitters and pickups will be allowed. (Hand loading only)
- Firewood will be for permit holder's use and not allowed for resale.
- Depositing trash (littering) of grounds is prohibited.
- All firewood cut by permit holder must be removed the same day it is cut.
- Firewood is available only to firewood cutting permit holder and must be in their possession while cutting and hauling out of the park. **Only permit holder can operate chain saw.**
- This firewood cutting and removal permit is valid until the supply of wood is gone or until the Hardin County Conservation Board determines to stop the firewood cutting at the designated site.
- Permit holders will be denied the privilege to cut and remove firewood if they have not met the terms of this agreement.
- The permit holder agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Hardin County, the Hardin County Conservation Board and its officers and employees from any and all liability, or personal injury or property loss, claims, costs, expenses and judgment, growing out of or related to, alleged injuries or damages of any nature whatsoever to any person, property or third person arising out of cutting and hauling of firewood from _____ Park.
- Only persons within the Iowa Emerald Ash Borer Quarantine can purchase firewood.
