Reasons for tax increase if proposed exceeds the current:

Increase in the General Supplemental levy rate due to maintaining current county services due to below 1% county growth rate, 43.98% increase-Tort Liability insurance premiums, 5% increase-health insurance premiums, 33% increase in juvenile legal and court related services.
